explanation of what happened that has lead them to their current situation since last application in September. Stanley Zeitz seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

- 2. 2012-10 F Stanley Zeitz moved to recommend application be approved as requested for two months of assistance with rent, electric, gas, water, internet, phone, and once submitted the principle amount for the auto loans. Assistance. Thomas Troxell seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.
- **3. 2014-06 G TIP** Stanley Zeitz moved to recommend application be approved as requested for past due rent to prevent eviction on applicant record, move in cost to include deposit, and 2 months' rent, plus auto payment payoff of \$1302.22. Thomas Troxell seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.
