 Teacher Ready is an alternative pathway program leading to **certification/licensure in Florida** and is sponsored through the University of West Florida. Though the Program itself is not “credit” based, the university does allow an option to apply 12 hours from the program towards completion of their masters degree programs - <http://uwf.edu/catalog/cat2007/curmed.pdf> The above cost is for the program itself (7 online modules). **Additional costs** will be incurred **for Florida testing requirements and Florida certification fees**. Many, but *not all Florida certifications reciprocate in Arizona*. It is best to consult with a TTT advisor to develop an appropriate tract that will eventual be accepted in Arizona. Once certification is reciprocated in Arizona, candidates will be required to complete a 3 credit course in Structured English Immersion.
